We have six scholarship awards to give away in 2023. That's €1,500 per annum for up to four years, for six lucky Heritage Credit Union members. To apply, simply complete the application details and return to any of our offices. At Heritage Credit Union, our Scholarship Awards Programme is just one of the ways we support our members in achieving their goals!

Full Scholarship Terms and Conditions Are Listed Below

- 1. Six third level scholarships will be awarded in 2023.
- 2.The Scholarships are for 4 consecutive years, or such shorter term where the course has less than 4 years to run.
- 3. Applicants must be active members of Heritage Credit Union.
- 4. The six successful recipients of the 2023 Scholarship Award, will be required to contribute four hours per month as volunteers / members of Heritage Credit Union, for the duration of their award term. These activities may include front office / back office duties and / or promotional activities to support Heritage Credit Union, when it engages with the community.
- 5. The successful applicants will be picked by lottery.
- 6. The successful applicants will receive the sum of €1,500 annually in the form of two payments of €750 paid out in October and January each year.
- 7. Applicants may apply for the scholarship for a second or subsequent year of study, even though they may not have applied in an earlier year of the course.
- 8. Applicants who were unsuccessful in a previous years scholarship awards may re-apply in subsequent years.
- 9. Should a successful applicant fail to enter their second or third year of study, or opt out of college within 3 years, their participation in the Scholarship will terminate.
- 10. Written confirmation of course attendance will be required prior to any payments being made.
- 11. Multiple applications whether by, or on behalf of, any applicant, will result in the exclusion of ALL applications in respect of that member from the lottery process.
- 12. Closing date for applications is Saturday, 16th September 2023, and the lottery will be conducted within two working weeks thereafter.
